

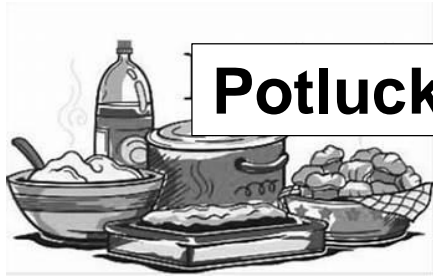
NEWS AND REMINDERS FOR THE TEHACHAPI CHURCH OF CHRIST FAMILY

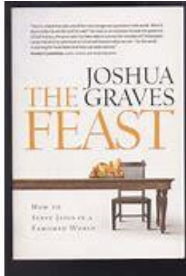

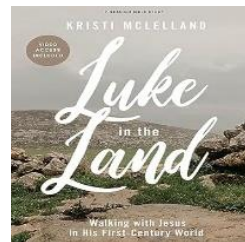
