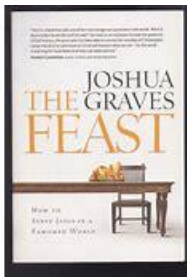

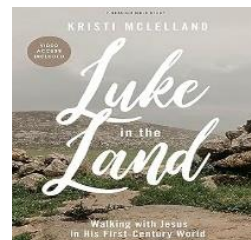
# New Wednesday Evening Bible Study
