"Trust, but verify", is one of the most often repeated lines from President Reagan. I believe he was saying that tongue-in-cheek, since the fact that verification is required seems to indicate that you actually do not trust the word of the "trustee". In politics, it does seem wise to trust only the actions of others, and not the words. Yet if you act in good faith, that really is trust.

Perhaps it is ironic that a royal official—one who lived in the world of politics—actually "took Jesus at his word" when he told him that his very sick child did not need an inperson visit in order to be healed (see John 4:47-54). Jesus simply said, "Your son will live", and the man soon got word that his son was well. When the man asked what time the change occurred, he was asking for verification, based on the time Jesus spoke those words. Did that mean he did not trust Jesus? No. Trust is an action, not a feeling.

When we ask God in Jesus' name for healing or relief or blessings, we can trust that He answers prayers without requiring a personal encounter. Trust Him. He knows what is best. Then remember to give God the credit when you survive and thrive. That verifies His love, and your faith will grow.
