

They didn't have to shepherd flocks of smelly sheep.

Jesus fed 5000 men one meal, and they chased him down the next day to ask him to do for them what Moses did in the wilderness. He offered something much better than fish and barley loaves. He offered his own body as bread and his blood as wine. It was not really surprising when they did not understand, but it was disappointing that they grumbled and many turned away from him.

I find myself complaining a lot about the prices of groceries and food at restaurants these days. What I don't do is go without meals or eat things I don't want to eat. Complaining about these things is not complaining about the government. It is complaining about God's ways of providing for our needs.

The worst thing we can do, however, is to fail to be grateful for our freedom from spiritual slavery. The enemy wants us to focus on our physical and emotional needs and desires, so that we won't even praise God for sending his son to save us from the anxiety that sin causes.
