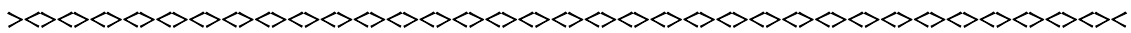

Those serving in other mission fields, including Blair's friend **Sandeep** in India

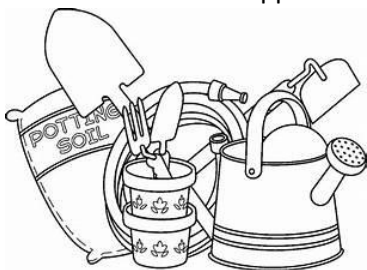
Pray for the homeless, and pray for **Blair** as he works to minister to them.
